New Dean Prof. Léon Laulusa announces the appointments of his management team

Following his appointment on 31 May 2023, Prof. Léon Laulusa has announced a new organisation chart for ESCP, taking effect on 1 July 2023 (unless otherwise stated).

The Management Board supporting Dean Laulusa includes:

- <u>Prof. Pramuan Bunkanwanicha</u>, as Dean of Faculty (starting his new role from 1 September 2023 as the result of the election)
- <u>Prof. Simon Mercado</u>, as Executive Vice-President in charge of Global Development, Partnerships, and Accreditations. He will also be the Dean of partner campuses and international branches (Warsaw and Dubai)
- <u>Prof. Francesco Rattalino</u>, as Executive Vice-President in charge of Academic Affairs and Student Experience (and Dean of the Turin campus until a successor is appointed)
- <u>Prof. Véronique Tran</u>, as Executive Vice-President in charge of Executive Education and Corporate Relations (and Dean of the Berlin campus until a successor is appointed)

The Executive Committee includes the members of the Management Board, together with:

- <u>Prof. Cécile Kharoubi</u>, as Dean of the Paris Campus (nominated from 1 September 2023), continuing her mission as Associate Dean of the Master in Management to ensure the transition with her successor until the end of 2023)
- <u>Prof. Régis Coeurderoy</u>, as Associate Dean for Research (starting his new role from 1 September 2023 as the result of the election)

- <u>Anaïs Ravet</u>, as Chief of staff and Director for Institutional Affairs, covering governance and legal affairs, and ensuring the transition until the appointment of the new Director of Studies of the MiM programme.

The other members of the Executive Committee remain in office:

- <u>Prof. Javier Tafur</u> and <u>Prof. Kamran Razmdoost.</u> respectively Deans of the Madrid and London campuses
- <u>Prof. Joe Miemczyk</u> will continue to serve as Associate Dean for Sustainability

Other federal support functions appointments are:

- <u>Dimitri Champollion</u>, as Executive Director for Digital Education reporting to the Executive Vice President in charge of Executive Education and Corporate Relations
- <u>Alexandre Lederman</u>, Affiliate Professor, as Director for Public Relations, reporting to the Dean
- <u>Nathalie Sokoloff</u>, as Director of Brand and Communications (appointed from 5 July 2023), reporting to the Dean
- <u>Romain Vincent</u>, as Stakeholder Engagement Director reporting to the Executive Vice President in charge of Academic Affairs and Student Experience
